2012 marks the 25th anniversary of the FDDB - *The Danish Association of the Deafblind*.

The ERCW is going to take place at Castberggård, the Folk High School for the Deaf and hard of hearing in Denmark.

Castberggård is a folk high school that offers a variety of different courses aimed at Deaf, hard of hearing, deaf-blind and cochlear implanted people. Courses range from actual skill building, labour-market oriented courses to courses in cultural awareness, sports and creative workshops.

The accommodation will mainly be in double rooms, but a few single rooms are available as well. Sanitary facilities are good.

Participation Fee

Participation fee amounts to DKK 3500 per person in a double room and DKK 4500 per person in a single room.

There is a frequent coach service between Billund Airport and Vejle.
